## **Fearon Reserve works update**

To: Williamstown Imperial Cricket Club, Williamstown CYMS Cricket Club, Williamstown CYMS Football Club, Williamstown Seagulls FIDA Football Club, Williamstown Lacrosse Club and Williamstown Women's Lacrosse Club.

Hi all, just a quick update on the works on Fearon Reserve which commenced in early October 2016.

The works have included:

- Stripped topsoil and reshaped surface levels.
- Installed a new irrigation system linked to Council's central control which included the installation of a larger water connection that services both ovals.
- Installed an underground drainage system.

Other works regarding the new cricket practice facility (on eastern side of Reserve) have included:

- Extending the cricket net facility by one wicket.
- Installed a new cricket pad (27m x12m) for three wickets.
- Installed a synthetic cover over whole pad.
- Installed a chain mesh along back of the facility with 5m fence extensions from back of the facility to separate the three nets.

Works still to be completed include:

- Extend two turf wicket tables by 1 wicket.
- Returf the whole reserve with grass sods.

The contractor has confirmed that grass turf will be obtained in late January. There has been a delay in obtaining good quality turf due to the cooler and wetter spring season. This means there is a possibility that the remainder of the works on the Reserve will be delayed. An update will be provided to you once the turf has been obtained in late January.
