

## Playing Junior Cricket at Willy Imperials - Equipment list\*

*\*NOTE – Junior Girls playing at Williamstown Imperials are provided with a full kit thanks to a generous sponsor (please contact the club to arrange)*

**The club has a shared kit which contains recommended / non-essential items listed below for all junior teams.** Junior players are also provided with:

- Playing shirt (all players)
- Hat (all new players)

It is expected players will bring their own:

- White cricket pants \* (mandatory for games)
- An abdominal guard (often called a box) \* (mandatory for training & games)
- Sunscreen
- Drink Bottle

It is also recommended players have their own:

- Helmet \* (mandatory for training & games)
  - While one is supplied in the club kit to share – sanitising helmets is difficult on the field and with that it is preferred that players supply their own helmets for comfort
- Cricket bag - to carry all of their equipment in. These come as long bags or more recently backpacks to make it easy to transport gear to and from training and cricket matches
- Cricket bat
- Batting Gloves
- Leg pads

Not essential:

- Cricket shoes (runners are more than ok at this level)
- Thigh pads (these are included in the club kit)
- Wicket Keeping Equipment
  - Players will rotate through the wicket keeper position throughout the season – gloves and pads are included in the team kit and not required to be purchased.
